Łomża can win over your heart. The town buildings are picturesquely located on the high Narew slope, meadows and river backwaters unfold throughout, and the flowery routes to the old part of town radiate a salutary tranquillity. It is enough to drop by to the Old Market Square, stroll along Dworna, Długa or Farna Streets, or sit for a moment on a bench among the greenery to understand, if only partially, why the always smiling Hanka Bielicka, whose acting prowess took her places, loved this town so much. The most important historical landmark of Łomża is the 16th-century cathedral, that is, the Church of Saints Michael the Archangel and John the Baptist, the oldest monument in north-eastern Poland. However, strolling along the streets of the town, you can see many more interesting buildings, e.g. the former Orthodox Church, the Governor's Palace and the Monasteries of the Capuchins and the Benedictine nuns. During the stroll it is worthwhile to stop by the old Catholic and Jewish Cemeteries with many beautiful tombstones.

Łomża grows more and more beautiful each year – mansions are renovated, streets are paved with cobble-stones, squares and colourful flower arrangements are created... Yet the town boasts another asset – the impressive territory of the Łomżyński Landscape Park of the Narew Valley, almost reaching the town's borders. Add the semi-wild areas of the nearing Narwiański and Biebrzański National Parks and several nature reserves to the mix, and Łomża becomes an excellent starting point for those who enjoy outdoor escapades. At the same time, you have an opportunity to visit a few interesting localities in the vicinity, for instance Stara Łomża, Nowogród, Drozdowo or Wizna. In short, there is plenty to see and admire here.
